I never thought my voice would be heard in a place like this. You see, I am just a donkey. No majestic mane like a stallion, no noble lineage, no claim to greatness. Just a humble beast of burden. But let me tell you about a day that changed everything —not just for me, but for the world.

It was a morning like any other in the little village of Bethphage. I was tied up, minding my business, when two men came and began untying me. I brayed in protest. Then they said something strange: "The Lord needs it."

The Lord? Me?

Before I knew it, I was being led to a man—kind eyes, dusty feet, calm like the sea after a storm. They called Him Jesus.

They placed cloaks on my back to make a saddle, and then He climbed on. I carried Him, the weight of Heaven itself, though He was light as mercy.

As we entered Jerusalem, something incredible happened. Crowds swarmed. They laid down more cloaks, waved palm branches, and shouted, "Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!" And there I was, in the middle of it all, carrying a King. Not a king with chariots and armies, but a King of peace. A King who chose *me*.

People didn't cheer for me. That's okay. They cheered for the One I carried. My job wasn't to be seen—but to lift up the One who saves.

That day taught me something I want you to remember: you don't have to be powerful, polished, or perfect to carry Christ. You just have to be willing. He chooses the humble. He uses the ordinary. He turns donkeys into royal transport.

So if you ever feel unworthy, too small, too broken—remember me. The donkey who bore the King. And ask yourself: Who might I be carrying today?
